RICARD GUERRERO

Full Professor of Microbiology at the University of Barcelona (1988-2013), Emeritus. Adjunct Professor at the University of Massachusetts-Amherst (2001-present). Fellow of following Academies: the Linnean Society, the American Academy of Microbiology, the Academia Europaea and the Institute for Catalan Studies. President of the Spanish Society for Microbiology, SEM (2007-2014) and Vice-president of the Confederation of Scientific Societies of Spain, COSCE (2013-present). As a consequence of his work, he has more than 400 publications on the biochemistry, genetics, and ecology of prokaryotes. Besides his activity in research and teaching at the university, he has worked on different programs and activities on behalf of the communication of science in Spain, Latin America, and the United States, and of the public understanding of science in different countries. He has been the curator of the permanent exhibition of the new Museum of Natural Sciences of Barcelona. Currently, he is the Academic Director of the Academia Europaea's office for the Mediterranean, located in Barcelona (Barcelona Knowledge Hub).
